Appropriate Casual Attire for Social (non-athletic) areas

- 1 Sport shirts and sweaters
- 2 T-shirts not dominated by writing, logos or printed designs
- 3 Slacks, clean and neat denim jeans
- 4 Tailored shorts, mid-thigh or longer
- 5 Clean, neat, warm-up suits, athletic shoes

Social Areas of the MAC include:

- Main Lobby, Cornerstone Lounge
- Library/Reading Lounge
- Stadium Terrace
- First-floor restaurants, Sports Pub, Seasons and Men's Bar
- Ballroom, Private Dining rooms
- Center Elevator and East Elevator (left)

KEY RULES

Attire never allowed in social areas:

- **Athletic attire***, except warm-up suits
- Rubber-soled flip flops
- Shower sandals
- Bare mid-ribs or bare feet
- Manual labour work clothes

Athletic attire*

Athletic attire: clothing that is designed for working out or playing a sport, even if the member or guest isn't wearing it for a specific athletic activity at the time.

Examples Include:

- Basketball or other sporty shorts
- Yoga garments, leggings
- Tennis skirts, shorts
- Running shorts, tights
- Sports uniforms, cleats
- Swimwear
- Aerobic apparel
- Martial arts uniforms (Keikogi or Dogi)

Appropriate Business or Business Casual Attire

- 1 Slacks
- 2 Collared shirts, sweaters or sport shirts
- 3 Dresses
- 4 Suits or coordinated pants or skirt ensembles

HATS

Hats and sport caps are prohibited in the Men's Bar with the exception of hats worn as part of a woman's formal ensemble, or head coverings with religious significance.
