TC MEETINGS: Team Captain's meeting will be held each morning at 8:00am in the lounge upstairs. Referees and course setters will be selected and approved by the TD and ROC prior to the first TC meeting. RACE HQ: Race HQ will be in the Race Place – ground floor of the lodge with entrance along the west end of the lodge (left side looking uphill)

LIFT PASS: \$30 lift tickets for PNSA juniors will be available each day. PNSA Elite Passes will be honored.

RACER BIBS: Bibs will be issued each morning at Registration. Bibs must be turned in at the scoreboard upon completion of the race each day. Racers will be charged \$50.00 for missing bibs.

AWARDS: Awards will be presented each day to the first 3 places in each age group according to Evergreen Cup rules. Unclaimed awards for Saturday can be picked up the next morning at Race Headquarters. Awards will not be mailed.
