Event Schedule: 5/26, Saturday: 8:30am Men SL/SL / Ladies SL/SL Pucci
5/27, Sunday: 8:30am Men SL/SL / Ladies SL/SL Pucci

Eligibility: All 2017-18 USSA licensed competitors, U14 and older are eligible to compete in the Golden Rose (born 2005 and earlier). Senior racers, ages 21 and older, must have less than 120 USSA SL points to enter.

Event Registration: Entry fees are \$48.00/race. Individuals must register and pay on-line at <https://usskiandsnowboard.org/> event registration. Direct registration questions to raceadmin@mhsef.org

Entry Deadline: All entries must be received by 11:59pm on Wednesday, May 23rd. Late registration **will not** be accepted. A list of registered athletes can be seen at USSS Event Registration or www.mthoodacademy.org beginning May 21st.

Out-of-division Entries: Out-of-division athletes will be allowed **IF** they meet the following point cut off: *Slalom points under 75 for women and under 50 points for men.* Out-of-Division athletes must first be cleared through their Divisional Office and then must register on-line by the entry deadline.

Field Size Limitation: The Golden Rose will be limited to 90 women and 90 men. *Additionally 12 men and 12 women WR Mt. Hood U14-16 SL Project athletes will be accepted into the field.* If necessary the field will first be cut by eliminating U14 competitors (YOB 2005) ranked by SL points on the current USSA points list. Further cuts will rank the entire field by current USSA Slalom points.

Lift Tickets: PNSA Elite Pass, Fusion Pass and Timberline winter pass will be accepted at the Golden Rose. A \$49.00 racer ticket will be available for all other competitors.

Race Headquarters: Race HQ will be open each morning from 6:30 to 7:30am in the WyEast Day Lodge.

TC Meeting: 7:30pm Friday the 26th at the Mt. Hood Academy Haus in Government Camp. The 2nd TC meeting will be Saturday right before awards in the Day Lodge.

Racer Bibs: Bibs will be issued at Athlete Check In **WITH** a hard copy of the MHSEF release. **No Release - No Bib.** Racers will use the same bib for all races. \$50.00 will be charged for lost or damaged bibs.

Awards: Presented each day to the top 3 in each Ability Class. The Golden Rose perpetual trophies are presented to the overall male and female with the lowest combined Race Points from all races.
