The forms are time stamped. Daily symptom forms filled out prior to the morning of the race will be deleted. If the forms are not filled out within the appropriate time lines athletes will not be allowed to compete.</p> <p>While in the venue, lodge area, tent, and lift lines MASKS/ FACE COVERINGS MUST be WORN. If you are not able to do this, do not register for this event.</p> <p>There will be no refunds for not complying with COVID protocols.</p> <p>There will be no scoreboard or awards ceremony.
