PNSA continues its investment in protection equipment for alpine competition with another purchase of 120 rolls of B-net from Barry Cordage, Inc. This purchase, along with the past 7 years of on-going investments, the 195 Barry Cordage, Inc. nets bought in 2011 and 80 replacement SPM nets in 2012, fulfills PNSA's goal of establishing 3 B-net depots throughout the division, with each depot having approximately 100 rolls of B-net. The depots are located in northern Oregon, one in eastern Washington and the final one in western Washington.

Member clubs can request use of the B-net for either training or competition purposes. The clubs are responsible for transporting the netting from and back to the depot. Clubs can submit their B-net usage requests to [Roger Root](#). Clubs must also complete and return the PNSA [B-net Usage Agreement](#) prior to picking up the fencing.
